Survey Supply Procurement Program (SSPP)

- Also known as Traps and Lures Program
- Manages average of 150 products - IPHIS catalog (traps, lures, and supplies)
- 115 products purchased commercially, stored at Moore Airbase (MAB) warehouse
- 29 lure types manufactured by PPQ Forest Pest Methods Laboratory (FPML)
- Approximate inventory managed at MAB -3.94 million items
- Product value = \$3.47 million (MAB)

Survey Supply Procurement Program (SSPP)

- MAB and FPML:
 - Average yearly
 - 500 orders
 - 250 recipients
 - 53 states/territories
 - 3.5 million items shipped
- 23 multi-year contracts for 55 commercial products (FY 2024) of June 2024)
 - 3-6 more planned in FY 2025
 - Balance costs
 - Quantities

Supply ordering periods

- **Period 1:**
 - Fall (September - November)
 - Supporting CAPS and PPQ program surveys
- **Period 2:**
 - Winter (January to March)
 - Supporting PPA 7721 Goal 1S surveys and any residual supply ordering needs
 - Currently open until March 14th, 2025

SSPP Projections

- How do we know what to order?
 - Resources:
 - Projections based on statistical analysis of last 3 years' ordering history
 - Input and direction from PPQ programs
 - Updated Priority Pest List and Approved Survey Methods
 - Budget availability
- When do we order?
 - As soon as we can
 - Continued resolutions

Integrated Plant Health Information System (IPHIS)- Survey Supply Procurement Program (SSPP)

- Platform approximately 12 years old
- Scheduled for full retirement in the next 2 to 3 years.
- SSPP module housed in the IPHIS system
 - Transitioned to another platform before IPHIS is retired
- IPHIS SSPP module is used by PPQ employees and non-PPQ cooperators
 - Ordering survey supplies (traps, lures, supplies) pests:
 - PPQ National Priority Pest List
 - PPQ Pest Programs
 - PPQ Cooperative Agreements
 - Facilitate a range of USDA-APHIS supported pest survey activities in the United States (U.S.) and U.S. territories

IPHIS- SSPP

- Hosts a catalog of approximately 200 traps, lures, products
- Full transition of all SSPP module functions from IPHIS to a new platform
 - Maintaining all essential functions of the system
 - Improvements: User Friendly, Intuitive, Smart
 - Familiar platform (Service Now, platform currently in use by PPA 7721)
- Ongoing effort
